#### **Community Manager Report**

- Inspection Program was Reviewed by Steve Hurwitz
  - Recognizes the need for Goals and Reports
  - Proposes Day-to-Day Management from the HOA Office
  - They are taking photos of homes and particularly Violations
  - On Violation Letters, 6% of Homeowners have reacted negatively
  - Changed Letter from "Violation Notice" to "ARB Notice"
    - ARB Members requested that HOA Staff give courtesy notice when changes like this are implemented
- Home Improvement Fair: Steve recommends that we propose this as a Program to the BoT
  On the Run generated \$10K in advertising in the month of February
- **Color Palette Inquiry:** Steve requested that the ARB retract it's written response to Joe Stein, Trustee, regarding the Color Palette Inquiry from last month
  - ARB Members rejected the request and resolved that the response should stand as is

  - Gotten lots of responses, mostly good

  - Most negative feedback from Single Family Homes
  - They do tend to get off the ledge once the process is explained to them
