Discussion of new guest pass wording for pool guidelines

- There was a suggestion to change the wording on the 2010 Pool Rules:
 - **Daily Guest Passes** Purchased Daily Guest passes are valid for single use. Any unused guest passes will expire at the end of the following season.
 - **10 Visit Guest Passes** The cost is \$35.00 per pass and unused guest passes expire at the end of the following swim season.

Pool Checklist

- The filter and pump system for Pool #3 should be installed prior to the pool opening, most likely the end of April or beginning of May.
- An engineer is currently looking into the concrete issue at pool #1. They believe that the issue may be bigger than originally thought. Now, they are planning to post pone the concrete surface repairs until the fall 2010 for all three pools.

- There was no update on the bathroom repairs for Pool #2. Chrystal will follow up on the status of the repairs.
- They are replacing the garbage cans and paper towel dispensers at pool #3. In addition, all three pools will get new toilet paper dispensers and shower seats.

2010 Pool Season Operating Hours

- The pool hours will be presented for approval at the April 4th BOT meeting.

Update on new Pool Pass program implementation

- The pool pass policy will be presented to the BOT for approval at the April 4th meeting.
- Marketing of the guest pass We want to make sure that residents know that unused guess passes are good for two years. Also, we want to remind them about the cost savings associated with buying in bulk (10 passes).
