What Prompts an ARB Inspection?

The LRR HOA is tasked with monitoring the appearance and exterior conditions of the 2,722 properties within Little Rocky Run, and ensuring that residents comply with the Architectural Standards that have been developed by the community. But what determines when and what property will be inspected? The answer is that several different scenarios can prompt a property inspection.

1) POAA Disclosure Inspections: When a property is offered for sale, the seller is required by law to purchase a disclosure document from the Homeowners Association (HOA) for potential buyers to review before going to settlement. This document includes a report on the physical condition of the exterior of the home and notes any potential discrepancies with the ARB Standards that are found during the inspection. These inspections are requested by the home seller and are performed by the ARB staff. The inspection report (estoppel) becomes a permanent part of the property file.

2) Community-wide Inspections: Each year, a community-wide inspection of every home, on every street within Little Rocky Run is conducted, to address the overall maintenance and curb appeal of the homes, to address such routine items as; yard maintenance, mildew on siding, exterior trim, fences, drainage pipes, etc.

The ARB staff performs these inspections, and owners/residents are notified by letter of what maintenance issues need to be corrected.

3) Submission of an ARB application: When a homeowner submits an ARB application for making exterior changes to a property, he/she grants permission for members of the ARB and Conservancy staff to inspect the property as part of the application review process. Photos of the property are often taken by the staff and included with the ARB's application review information.

4) Complaints: When a complaint is made about a property violation existing within the community, the ARB staff must visit the site to determine whether or not a violation exists. Once a violation has been verified by the staff, a citation is issued to the property owner.

With just a small inspection team dedicated to covering a very large community, the staff must make efficient use of their time while out visiting properties. This means that the staff and ARB members will often make note of potential concerns on neighboring properties when they are out doing inspections. Once a concern has been noted, the staff will work to assist homeowners in resolving any issues found at the property.

Did You Know...

Tree Swings attached to branches of a tree are only allowed in the **rear** of the property. These are normally in the form of a disk-style or infant type seat, attached to a rope which is installed on a low hanging branch of the tree. These tree swings do not require ARB approval, as they are considered 'temporary', but may <u>**not**</u> be located on trees at the front or sides of the homeowner's property or on trees located on the Open Space.
