Proper Mulching Techniques

Mulches are materials placed over the soil surface to maintain moisture and improve soil conditions. Mulching is one of the most beneficial things a home owner can do for the health of a tree. Mulch can reduce water loss from the soil, minimize weed competition, and improve soil structure. Properly applied, mulch can give landscapes a handsome, well-groomed appearance. Mulch must be applied properly; if it is too deep, it can actually cause significant harm to trees.

Proper Mulching

It is clear that the choice of mulch and the method of application can be important to the health of landscape plants. The following are some guidelines to use when applying mulch.

- Inspect plants and soil in the area to be mulched. Determine whether drainage is adequate. Determine whether there are plants that may be affected by the choice of mulch. Most commonly available mulches work well in most landscapes. Some plants may benefit from the use of slightly acidifying mulch such as pine bark.
- If mulch is already present, check the depth. Do not add mulch if there is a sufficient layer in place. Rake the old mulch to break up any matted layers and to refresh the appearance. Some landscape maintenance companies spray mulch with a water-soluble, vegetable-based dye to improve the appearance.
- If mulch is piled against the stems or tree trunks, pull it back several inches so that the base of the trunk and the root crown are exposed. Mulch piled high against the trunk or stems of plants can stress tissues and may lead to insect and disease problems.
- Organic mulches usually are preferred to inorganic materials due to their soil-enhancing properties. If organic mulch is used, it should be well aerated and, preferably, composted. Avoid sour-smelling mulch.
- Composted wood chips can make good mulch, especially when they contain a blend of leaves, bark, and wood. Fresh wood chips also may be used around established trees and shrubs. Avoid using noncomposted wood chips that have been piled deeply without exposure to oxygen.
- For well-drained sites, apply a 2- to 4-inch layer of mulch. If there are drainage problems, a thinner layer should be used. Avoid placing mulch against the tree trunks. Place mulch out to the tree's drip line or beyond.

Reminder:

As landscape companies or local fundraisers are selling and delivering mulch bags, these items are to be properly stored inside garages or at the rear of the property, not at the front of residences, driveways or sidewalks.

WHAT DO THE MARKINGS MEAN?

Many people call us wondering why grass near their home marked or what the markings mean.



Utility color codes are used to identify existing underground utilities in construction areas with the intent of protecting them from damage during excavation. This is done through flags or a special spray paint, neither of which will cause long-term harm to your lawn.

The American Public Works Association (APWA) Uniform Color Codes for temporary marking of underground utilities are listed below:

Redelectric power lines, cables, conduit, and lighting cablesOrangetelecommunication, alarm or signal lines, cables, or conduitYellownatural gas, oil, steam, petroleum, or other gaseous or flammable materialGreensewers and drain linesBluepotable (drinkable) waterPurplereclaimed water, irrigation, and slurry linesWhiteproposed excavation limits or route

In Virginia, the Virginia Utility Protection Service, commonly called "Miss Utility of Virginia" shares these common examples of residential work that require a call prior to digging. Installation of landscaping, digging holes for fence posts and mail boxes, anchoring supports for decks or swings, removing tree roots, driving landscaping stakes into the ground or installing a retaining wall. Little Rocky Run Protect Our Water: Only Rain in the Drain



Storm drain markers on drains across Fairfax County tell us that anything washed or dumped down a storm drain goes directly into our streams, not to a water treatment plant. Our nearest stream, Occoquan Reservoir, leads to the Potomac River, a source of drinking water and recreation.

Don't let pollutants from these sources go down the drain. Prevention is easy!

- Sediment: Bare soil, sand.
 Grow native plants and use mulch on bare soil.
- Nutrients: Fertilizer, yard debris.
 Limit fertilizer use, compost or bag yard debris, practice bay-friendly yard care.
- **Toxics:** Pesticides, motor oil, lead-based paint, salt.
 - Keep suds from car washing out of the storm drain they can be toxic to wildlife.
 - Use pesticides only when necessary and sweep up excess.
 - Dispose of motor oil, lead-based paint and pesticides as household hazardous waste. One gallon of oil can pollute two million gallons of water.
- Pathogens: Animal or human waste.
 Scoop the poop! Keep bacteria from dog waste out of waterways.
- Litter: Plastic, cigarettes, styrofoam, cans. - Put litter in the recycling or trash.

Prevent and report storm drain dumping. If you see hazardous wastes like paint, pesticides, or motor oil dumped in storm drains, report it to Fairfax County at 703-691-2131, TTY 711.

Only Rain in the Storm Drain! Make sure that nothing other than water ever goes down your storm drain. Help keep water safe for children and future generations.

As of July 1997, Virginia House Bill 2565 provides that the delivery of **property owners' association disclosure documents** cannot be varied by agreement or waived.

All new home buyers **MUST** receive LRR HOA disclosure documents from the seller. These documents "disclose" all information relating to the ownership of the home, including outstanding delinquencies and architectural violations.

Please contact the office of Summit Management Services, Inc. (agent for Little Rocky Run HOA), at least two (2) weeks prior to your sale to ensure receipt of the documents. You do not need to wait for a purchaser to order the resale packet.
