Architectural Review Board on Trash Policy

ittle Rocky Run HOA frequently receives calls regarding the improper storage of Ltrashcans and recycle bins, and trash/garbage being put out for pickup in plastic bags. This is a problem that has historically been more prevalent in townhouse communities, where storage and access to rear yards are limited, however, it is also becoming a more frequent issue in single-family homes as well. What is happening is that residents are continuously leaving trash and/or recycle bins out after their scheduled pick up days. Even if the bins are left sitting on private property, they are still visible to others and that is seen as a potential detraction from the community's overall appeal. Leaving bins on the front or along the side of the property, behind shrubbery for example, or sitting at the end of a driveway, are not appropriate ways to store or screen receptacles from view. With the onset of spring, many neighbors will try to put their homes on the market and will be looking for the best price possible. People areasking the Little Rocky Run staff to intervene with this article to make all residents aware of this problem and to ask everyone to ensure trash/recycle bins are properly stored on non-collection days. This will allow Little Rocky Run's beauty to become even more visible for the people who live here or visit, or consider buying a home here.

The approved Board of Trustees trash policy reads: "Trash must be placed in rodent/animal-proof trash cans with a lid. Trash or garbage may not be put out in plastic garbage bags. Trash cans shall not be overstuffed, in order to allow proper closure of the can. All garbage must be placed curbside in front of your home, no earlier than 5:00 pm on the night before the scheduled pick-up day. Trash cans and recycle bins must be removed from the curbside, no later than 8:00pm the same evening of the scheduled pick-up day.

For Attached Properties (Townhomes) - "Trash must be placed in rodent/ animal-proof trash cans with a lid. Trash or garbage may not be put out in plastic garbage bags. All garbage must be placed curbside in FRONT of your home, or at the egress sidewalk closest to the front of your home (only if your home faces this egress sidewalk), no earlier than 5:00 pm on the night before the scheduled pick-up day. TRASH MUST NOT BE PUT IN THE COMMON AREAS OR ISLANDS FOR TRASH PICKUP. Trash cans and recycle bins must be removed no later than 8:00pm the same evening of the scheduled pick-up day".

"All garbage, to include: yard debris, trash and recycled material shall not be allowed to accumulate on the exterior of any property. Additionally, the disposal of debris or trash on the common areas is strictly prohibited".

The Little Rocky Run staff recognizes the challenges many residents face with keeping bins, trash cans and toters out of site, and we appreciate your efforts. We are all tasked with adhering to the current standards to maintain the aesthetics of the community. If you have ideas or suggestions that you think might help residents better comply with the ARB Standards, please submit comments to the ARB staff at arb@littlerockyrunhoa.org.

REMINDER:

In accordance with Fairfax County code ordinances, all residents must clean up dog waste from their pets, at the time of each occurrence, and should properly dispose of the waste in a sealed bag, in an appropriate dispenser. For your convenience, there are dog waste dispensers located throughout the community. Disposing of the dog waste into the grassy or wooded common areas or into residents personal trash containers is not allowed.

Dog Talk: 🍄 🔥 🏘 🎸

The HOA fields calls every day regarding pets in the neighborhood. The majority of complaints involve excess barking, loose or unleased dogs, pet waste and pets on private property. It is Little Rocky Run's policy for all residents to adhere to all Fairfax County guidelines and ordinances in regards to animal control. All dogs must be kept under leash control at all times and are not permitted to foul others' property. Owners shall not allow pets to run loose or walk dogs on other residents' private property. Dogs can be walked on Little Rocky Run open space, however they must be on leash and in your control at all times. The waste needs to be cleaned up and disposed of properly. Open

space areas are routinely used as play areas for children, so waste cleanup and proper disposal are imperative. In addition, pet waste is not to accumulate on your own property.
