Highlights from July 24, 2014 regular BoT Meeting held at RC #2

Trustees present: Scott McAuliffe, Joe Stein, Ron Mulvihill, Jerre Thomas, John Lindsay, Ralph Valentino, and Mark Gross

Meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM.

The Board of Trustees approved by unanimous consent for Mr. Mark Gross to fill the 1 year Board of Trustees vacant seat.

At 7:10 the Board moved into Executive Session to discuss matters with the attorneys from Whiteford, Taylor and Preston.

The Board reconvened into open session at 8:05.

Set Agenda was approved.

Mr. Lee Kauffman delivered the Managers report.

The June 19, 2014 Board Meeting minutes were approved.

The Board accepted the June 16, 2014 Architectural Review Board Minutes, the June 17, 2014 Community Activities Committee Minutes, the June 25, 2014 Pool Committee Minutes and the June 24, 2014 Tennis Committee Meeting Minutes.

The BoT reviewed the May 2014 Financials.

The BoT reviewed the ARB Community Wide Inspection Update.

The BoT discussed the financial management services.

The BoT approved Daly, Hamad & Associates, P.L.L.C. for the 2014 audit not to exceed \$10,500 with a second year option.

The BoT approved Closet Prep & Paint for the painting and repairing of Little Rocky Run wooden bridges. The project is not to exceed \$8,500.

The BoT approved Clear Blue's proposal to replace the Dry Dek at Pools 2 & 3. The project is not to exceed \$17,700.

The BoT approved Absolute Flooring for the refinishing of Rec center #1 floor. The project is not to exceed \$1,600.

# **Important Note about Yard Waste Collection**

With the warm weather months upon us, more people are out gardening and doing yard maintenance and lawn improvements. Please keep the following guidelines in mind when putting your lawn and yard waste debris out for pickup:

Routine yard waste pickup for the single-family residences is scheduled for every Wednesday by the trash service company, from March through December. Yard debris waste pickup for the townhome residences is scheduled for every Friday during these same months. **Grass clippings and leaves must be placed in clear plastic bags or brown paper lawn bags for pickup**.

Please refrain from putting out your yard debris for pickup before 5:00 PM on the night before the scheduled pick-up day. This rule also applies to putting out your trash containers and recycling bins for trash pickup. Putting out lawn debris and trash containers out earlier than the evening before pickup is unsightly and detracts from the beauty of our community.

Architectural and Maintenance Standards July 12, 2007, Revised Trash Policy #29(a); Yard Debris: Grass clippings and leaves are to be placed out in clear plastic bags or brown paper bags (black plastic bags will not be picked up on yard debris days). Tree limbs and brush must be no longer than (4) four feet in length and no thicker than (6) six inches thick in diameter. These items must be tied with rope or twine in arm length bundles. Bagged or bundled items are not to exceed 50 lbs. Brush is defined as the woody part of tree trimmings or pruning with a branch and/or trunk diameter of six inches or less. Unbound piles of branches will not be picked up.

# Pet Waste

Little Rocky Run has been asked to print Fairfax County guidelines and ordinances pertaining to pets, in particular the "Leash Law", "Pooper Scooper" and "Noise" regulations. Animal Control has been authorized to pick up dogs, cats and other animals that pose a public nuisance or threaten public safety or health.

It is against the law to allow animals to run loose on public property or the private property of others. Dogs must be restrained by a dependable leash and controlled by a responsible person when off the property of the owner. Dog owners must pick-up waste deposited by their pets on others' property or in any common areas. Pet waste is also not to be picked up/cleaned from your own property and then disposed of in the common area open space.

"The owner or custodian of any dog shall be responsible for the removal of excreta deposited by such dog on the property of another, including public areas (County Code Sections 41-1-2, 108-5-2 and 41- 2-6). The county law requiring pet owners to pick up waste on public or another's private property is too often being disregarded. Pet owners are asked to please do their part to keep the environment healthy and clean. Violations of these animal regulations may result in a fine ranging from \$250 to up to \$2,500. Animals that howl, bark, meow, or squawk frequently and habitually are declared a noise disturbance any time when plainly audible across property lines or through partitions.

For more information on specific regulations or how to retrieve a pet that has been impounded visit fairfaxcounty.gov/ living/animals. To report an infraction call (703) 691-2131 and ask for an Animal Control Officer.

## Architectural Review Board

Homeowners living in planned communities typically enjoy better



property values that are associated with having architectural standards for their neighborhoods. Architectural standards are upheld in Little Rocky Run by an all-volunteer Architectural Review Board (ARB) that is assisted by employees

dedicated to this function at the HOA office. Thanks to these members of the community, the ARB is active and dedicated to maintaining the busy application/violation workload.

What do the ARB members do? ARB members make decisions on homeowner applications for exterior modifications, and recommend properties with ongoing ARB violations to the Board of Trustees for corrective action and/or legal action.

Primary Duties: The ARB is required to review, modify and approve or disapprove written applications submitted by homeowners for exterior architectural changes. Applications are reviewed for conformance with the criteria and goal set forth in the Covenants of Little Rocky Run's Architectural Standards.

ARB members are required to attend the monthly Architectural meetings (typically held the 3rd Monday of each month in the evening) for review of submitted ARB applications and maintenance violation hearings. ARB members also need to have time available to dedicate for a rotating schedule for weekend review of properties which have submitted applications for exterior modifications. These weekend reviews typically rotate on an every 4th or 6th weekend, depending on the number of ARB members currently active on the ARB.
