Our community is only as good as we make it, and establishing and maintaining a sense of community is a part of a Board Member's responsibility. If your trash is not picked up by 3:00 PM on your scheduled day, please call American Disposal. If your trash is not removed within 24 hours after your call to American Disposal, please call the HOA Office at 703-830-0411. Feel free to leave a message if calling after hours.

Yard Waste Collection: Ends effective December 24th. If you have yard waste to be collected after this date, place your items curbside on your 2nd collection day until yard waste collection season resumes the 1st week in March.

Damaged Recycle Bins may be traded in for

replacements at no cost from American Disposal. If you are new to the neighborhood and don't have a recycle bin, contact the HOA office to pick one up.



Inclement Weather: Safety in Little Rocky Run is American Disposals primary concern. Roads and/ or areas which are deemed unsafe due to snow or ice will be suspended for collection.



Christmas Tree Collection: Single family and multi-dwelling attached homes, Christmas trees will be collected on January 7th and January 14th. American Disposal asks that all tinsel and decorations be removed. Please do not place trees in plastic bags.

Christmas Day & New Year's Day: Falls on a Thursday this year. American Disposal office is closed and no services will be provided. Single family homes, since your regular trash & recycling pickup falls on this day, trash & recycling collection make up day will be the Satruday after each holiday. (December 27th and January 3rd)



On make-up days, crews come through neighborhoods earlier than normal, please make sure trash & recycling itmes are curbside the night before.







Top Tips for Safe Online Holiday Shopping

Before you start your holiday shopping, remember to **STOP. THINK. CONNECT.**: Make sure security measures are in place, understand the consequences of your actions and behaviors and enjoy the benefits of the Internet.

- Keep a Clean Machine: All the devices you use for shopping including smartphones and tablets should have up-to-date software including security software, operating systems, programs and apps.
- When in Doubt, Throw it Out: Links in email, tweets, posts, and online advertising are often the way cybercriminals compromise your computer. If it looks suspicious, even if you know the source, it's best to delete or if appropriate, mark as junk email.
- Think Before you Act: Be wary of communications that offer amazing deals that sound too good to be true, implore you to act immediately including those about a problem with an order or payment or ask you to view the website via a provided link.
- Get Savvy about Wi-Fi Hotspots: Don't share personal or financial information over an unsecured network (a connection that doesn't require a password for access). Using the direct web access on your phone (via a 3G/4G connection) is safer than an unsecured wireless network when on your mobile device.
- Make Sure the Site is Legitimate: This includes a closed padlock on your web browser's address bar or a URL address that begins with shttp or https. This indicates that the purchase is encrypted or secured. For new sites, check online reviews.
- **Protect your Personal Information:** Be alert to the kinds of information being collected to complete the transaction. Make sure the information requested is only that needed to complete the transaction. Only fill out required fields on checkout forms. Check the website's privacy policy. Make sure you understand how your information will be stored and used.
- Use Safe Payment Options: Credit cards are generally the safest option because they allow buyers to seek a credit from the issuer if the product isn't delivered or isn't what was ordered. Credit cards may have a limit on the monetary amount you will be responsible for paying. Never send cash through the mail or use a money-wiring service.
- Keep a Paper Trail: Save records of your online transactions, including the product description, price, online receipt, terms of the sale, and copies of email exchanges with the seller. Read your credit card statements as soon as you get them to make sure there aren't any unauthorized charges. If there is a discrepancy, call your bank and report it immediately.

Architectural Review Board



Homeowners living in planned communities typically enjoy better property values that are associated with having architectural standards for their neighborhoods. Architectural standards are upheld in Little Rocky Run by an all-

volunteer Architectural Review Board (ARB) that is assisted by employees dedicated to this function at the HOA office. Thanks to these members of the community, the ARB is active and dedicated to maintaining the busy application/violation workload.

What do the ARB members do? ARB members make decisions on homeowner applications for exterior modifications, and recommend properties with ongoing ARB violations to the Board of Trustees for corrective action and/or legal action.

Primary Duties: The ARB is required to review, modify and approve or disapprove written applications submitted by homeowners for exterior architectural changes. Applications are reviewed for conformance with the criteria and goal set forth in the Covenants of Little Rocky Run's Architectural Standards.

ARB members are required to attend the monthly Architectural meetings (typically held the 3rd Monday of each month in the evening) for review of submitted ARB applications and maintenance violation hearings. ARB members also need to have time available to dedicate for a rotating schedule for weekend review of properties which have submitted applications for exterior modifications. These weekend reviews typically rotate on an every 4th or 6th weekend, depending on the number of ARB members currently active on the ARB.
