The Architectural Review Board is searching for new ARB members and wel¬comes any LRR resident in good standing interested in serving, to apply. The commitment involves 1 meeting per month (third Mondays at 7pm), and time spent performing on-site inspections of new applications every sixth or seventh weekend on a rotating schedule.

Fall is here once again, along with weekends spent raking leaves and bagging yard debris, one downside to living in a beautifully wooded community. American Disposal does provide pick-up for this material as long as it is prepared properly (Leaves placed in clear plastic; brush bundled in 4 foot lengths).

At no time is yard waste to be dumped in Common Areas. This activity not only creates unsightly brush piles visible to the public, but also poses a fire hazard. If the Common Area is also a Resource Protection Area, dumping is prohibited by Virginia State and County law. The HOA urges all residents to adhere to this practice as it is a violation of the following HOA resolution:

Encroachment Policy Resolution; Dec 2005: No owners, residents or the family members, guests, agents, or invitees of owners or residents shall place or install anything upon the Common Areas or otherwise disturb or modify the Common Areas in any way without the expressed, prior written approval of the Architectural Review Board for design and the approval of the Board of Trustees for use.

Verizon Fios Update

Verizon Fios is going ahead and designing the job for Springstone Drive and the connecting streets; except for Union Spring Lane. The houses that haven't responded to the required easements will be deferred until easements are recieved. Verizon Fios is going to place the appropriate fiber to feed these homes for the future should easements be obtained. If Verizon receives easements before the job is sent out to construction, they will go ahead and expand the fiber to cover those homes. Once the Springstone Drive project is designed, Verizonwill start designing the project that covers Union Village Circle and the streets coming off Union Village Circle. The Union Village Circle project also has some streets that they have no easements received, so those streets will be deferred until the easements are received. Verizon Fios will resend the letter requesting an easement from those residents either via a door hanger notice or via Postal Mail. Please keep an eye out for these letters which will have to be filled out by the Resident Owner and notarized. The HOA office does provide notary services. Please contact the HOA office to schedule an appt. with the community manager, Lee Kauffman for the notary service.

<u>If your trash is not picked up by 3:00pm on your scheduled day</u>, please call American Disposal. If your trash is not removed within 24 hours after your call to ADS, please call the HOA Office at 703-830-0411. Feel free to leave a message if calling after hours.

Little Rocky Run Winter/Holiday Service Schedule

<u>CHRISTMAS DAY/NEW YEARS DAY:</u> Office is closed and no services will be provided. Town Homes since your regular trash & recycling pickup falls on this day, trash & recycling collection makeup day will be the Wednesday after the holiday (December 26th & January 2nd).

On make-up days, crews come through neighborhoods earlier than normal, please make sure you put your items curbside the night before

<u>YARD DEBRIS COLLECTION</u>: Ends effective December 28th unless your contract specifies otherwise. IF you have yard debris to be collected after this date, place your items to curbside on your 2nd collection day until yard debris season resumes the 1st week of March.

<u>CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION</u>: Single family and multi-dwelling attached homes, Christmas trees will be collected on the 1st two Wednesday's in January. We ask all tinsel and decorations be removed. Please do not place trees in plastic bags.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: Safety in your community is our primary concern. Roads and/or areas which are deemed unsafe due to snow or ice will be suspended for collection. If suspension occurs, service will resume based on the contract terms.

Trash & Recycling Schedule

<u>Single Family Homes</u> Recycling - Thursday Trash - Monday/Thursday

<u>Town Homes</u> Recycling - Tuesday Trash - Tuesday/Friday

Yard Debris pick up will run through December 28th. Pickup days will be

Wednesday for Single Family Homes and Friday for Townhomes.

As a reminder, yard debris or "yard waste" is defined as grass clippings, leaves, small twigs/branches and brush that results from general yard and landscape maintenance. Brush is defined as the woody part of tree trimmings or pruning with a branch and/or trunk diameter of six inches or less. Brush shall be cut in lengths of 4 foot or less by residents, and bundled and tied or placed in clearly marked rigid containers.

Special Pickups (Large Items)

American Disposal will arrange a special collection of some large items at no extra charge. Some items will incur an additional charge such as refrigerators, dish washers, washing machines, etc. Call American Disposal at 703-368-0500 or visit them online at

<u>www.americandisposal.com</u> for more information.

Special pickups are usually made on the second regular collection day of the week if you call <u>at least 72 hours in advance</u>. Please remember it is illegal to dump refuse of any sort on property belonging to others around our neighborhood.

EAGLE SCOUT CANDIDATE CLEANS LIT-TLE ROCKY RUN STREAM WETLANDS

Little Rocky Run Boy Scout Kevin Bishop chose as his Eagle Scout project a cleanup of the wetlands directly beside Bent Tree Apartments. This portion of the Little Rocky Run watershed had never been cleaned and was selected for cleanup by Friends of Little Rocky Run's Ned Foster. In fact, it was so over-grown that few humans had even been in it, much less cleaned it. The area is a morass of brambles, vines, mud and decades of trash.

Kevin and 36 volunteers from LRR Troop 577 picked up trash that weighed 2,370 lbs. Included in the offal was enough trash to fill 54 VDOT orange bags, along with 11 tires, two couches, miscellaneous metal, furniture, plywood, counter tops, and a gallon of antifreeze. All of this was taken to the West Ox Road landfill and properly disposed of. Although the area cleaned was actually fairly small in area, the amount of trash removed was astonishing.
