Please place your trash and recycling in appropriate, secure containers **no sooner than 6pm the night before** your scheduled pick up day and promptly remove emptied containers from you front curb or open space on pick up day.

<u>If your trash is not picked up by 3:00pm on your scheduled day</u>, please call American Disposal. If your trash is not removed within 24 hours after your call to ADS, please call the HOA Office at 703-830-0411. Feel free to leave a message if calling after hours.

Little Rocky Run Winter/Holiday Service Schedule

NEW YEARS DAY: Office is closed and no services will be provided. Town Homes since your regular trash & recycling pickup falls on this day, trash & recycling collection makeup day will be the Wednesday after the holiday (December 26th & January 2nd).

On make-up days, crews come through neighborhoods earlier than normal, please make sure you put your items curbside the night before

<u>CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION</u>: Single family and multi-dwelling attached homes, Christmas trees will be collected on the 1st two Wednesday's in January. We ask all tinsel and decorations be removed. Please do not place trees in plastic bags.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: Safety in your community is our primary concern. Roads and/or areas which are deemed unsafe due to snow or ice will be suspended for collection. If suspension occurs, service will resume based on the contract terms.

Trash & Recycling Schedule

<u>Single Family Homes</u> Recycling - Thursday Trash - Monday/Thursday

<u>Town Homes</u> Recycling - Tuesday Trash - Tuesday/Friday

Yard Debris pick up will run through

December 28th. Pickup days will be Wednesday for Single Family Homes and Friday for Townhomes.

As a reminder, yard debris or "yard waste" is defined as grass clippings, leaves, small twigs/branches and brush that results from general yard and landscape maintenance. Brush is defined as the woody part of tree trimmings or pruning with a branch and/or trunk diameter of six inches or less. Brush shall be cut in lengths of 4 foot or less by residents, and bundled and tied or placed in clearly marked rigid containers.

Special Pickups (Large Items)

American Disposal will arrange a special collection of some large items at no extra charge. Some items will incur an additional charge such as refrigerators, dish washers, washing machines, etc. Call American Disposal at 703-368-0500 or visit them online at

<u>www.americandisposal.com</u> for more information. Special pickups are usually made on the second regular collection day of the week if you call <u>at least 72 hours in</u> <u>advance.</u>

Swim Lessons Now for Summer Stingrays?

Yes! Despite the cold, many of our Stingrays are still swimming—indoors! Winter swim is not only fun, but also a great way to stay in shape and retain technical swim skills acquired over the summer. Stingrays Coach Bob Brofft and the Stingrays BOD highly recommend swim lessons before the start of summer swim team. Swim lessons now are especially beneficial for kids who are moving up to a new age group or who are brand new to the swim team. Our swim team is not a "learn to swim" program, so even new, young Stingrays should be able to swim before attending Stingrays practices.

As one parent to another, I can tell you firsthand that swim lessons are a good idea. When my son turned 9, he struggled to adjust from 25M competitions to 50M competitions and to the associated practices. And with my 6-year old daughter, I underestimated the regression that would occur between the summer she learned to swim and the next summer when she wanted to join swim team. Both my children would have had an even more positive swim team experience had I helped them prepare before the start of the season.
