### **Community Wide Inspections in Process**

As summer approaches in full swing, the ARB staff will be continuing with the Communitywide property inspections. Inspections will be commencing into the Wild Brook and Woods Run areas in the coming weeks. Below is a list of the (10) most prevalent maintenance issues we are finding on properties. These are not the only issues we are finding on properties, but are the most common and re-occurring. Get a jump start on your property to see if any of these compliance issues exist on your property:

Mildew on siding Deteriorated exterior wood trim (roofline trim, window and door trim) Fence in disrepair (missing and/or warped boards) and/or improper installed gates Broken/deteriorated roof vents Garage doors damaged/deteriorated Recreational/play equipment stored at front property Unburied drainage pipes Deck deteriorated and/or in need of staining Grass overgrown/ Shrubs/trees overgrown

### **Important Note about Yard Waste Collection**

With the warm weather months upon us, more people are out gardening and doing yard maintenance and lawn improvements. Please keep the following guidelines in mind when putting your lawn and yard waste debris out for pickup:

Routine yard waste pickup for the single-family residences is scheduled for every Wednesday by the trash service company, from March through December. Yard debris waste pickup for the townhome residences is scheduled for every Friday during these same months. **Grass clippings and leaves must be placed in clear plastic bags or brown paper lawn bags for pickup.** 

Please refrain from putting out your yard debris for pickup before <u>5:00</u> pm on the night before the scheduled pick-up day. This rule also applies to putting out your trash containers and recycling bins for trash pickup. Putting out lawn debris and trash containers out earlier than the evening before pickup is unsightly and detracts from the beauty of our community.

Architectural and Maintenance Standards July 12, 2007, Revised Trash Policy #29(a); Yard Debris: Grass clippings and leaves are to be placed out in clear plastic bags or brown paper bags (black plastic bags will not be picked up on yard debris days). Tree limbs and brush must be no longer than (4) four feet in length and no thicker than (6) six inches thick in diameter. These items must be tied with rope or twine in arm length bundles. Bagged or bundled items are not to exceed 50 lbs. Brush is defined as the woody part of tree trimmings or pruning with a branch and/or trunk diameter of six inches or less. Unbound piles of branches will not be picked up.

# Spring Is Well Into Swing! Summer Is Close Behind!

Remember, everyone enjoys being outside! Please be sure to follow the law when taking your dog on a family walk, or allowing your pet outside in the yard. Leash Laws are there to protect everyone! Scooping Doggy Poo is also a way to ensure sanitary conditions and is courteous to others.

Also, please do not leave pets outside, as barking is a nuisance to all. Pets should be kept inside with plenty of water.

Here are a few of the laws you should be aware of....

### Section 41.1-2-15. Permitting animals to trespass.

The owner of any animal, after being requested by the owner or tenant of any premises not to permit the animal to trespass upon such premises, shall not allow any such animal to go upon such premises. (26-04-41.1.)

**Section 41.1-2-6.** - Animals causing unsanitary conditions. It shall be unlawful for the owner of any animal or animals to keep such animal or animals in such a manner as to cause unsanitary conditions. The owner or custodian of any dog shall be responsible for the removal of excreta deposited by such dog on the property of another, including public places. (26-04-41.1.)

Section 41.1-2-4. - Unrestricted dogs prohibited; leash law.(a) No dog shall run unrestricted, as defined in Section 41.1-1-1, in the County. Any person who is the owner of a dog found unrestricted in the County shall be in violation of this Section. This Section shall not apply to any person who uses a dog under his direct supervision while lawfully hunting, while engaged in a supervised formal obedience training class or show, during formally sanctioned field trials, while a dog is in an area owned, leased, controlled, or operated by Fairfax County designated by resolution of the Board of Supervisors as an off-leash dog exercise area, or while a dog is in an area owned, leased, controlled, or operated by the Fairfax County Park Authority and designated by resolution of the Fairfax County Park Authority as an off-leash or dog exercise area, or while a dog is in an area, leased, controlled, or operated by the Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority and designated by resolution of the Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority Board as an off-leash or dog exercise area, or if a dog is a service animal whose handler is unable because of a disability to use a harness, leash, or other tether, or the use of a harness, leash, or other tether would interfere with the service animal's safe effective performance of work or tasks, in which case the service animal must be otherwise under the handler's control (e.g., voice control, signals, or other effective means). It is a violation of this Section for any owner of a dog to place such dog or allow it to be placed into custody of any person not physically capable of maintaining effective control of restricting such dog.

(b) Any dog found unrestricted in violation of subsection (a) shall be impounded, except that if the rightful owner of the dog can be immediately ascertained and located, then that owner shall be allowed to have custody of the animal, but shall be subject to issuance of a summons for violation of this Section. (26-04-41.1; 10-11-41.1.)
