Community Wide Property Inspections In Process

Below are the (10) ten most frequently cited maintenance violations being found on the community wide property inspections. These inspections are in full swing and will continue throughout the summer and fall of 2013.

- 1. Mildew on siding
- 2. Deteriorated exterior wood trim
- 3. Fence in disrepair (missing and/or warped boards)
- 4. Garage doors damaged/deteriorated
- 5. Roofline vents deteriorated/peeling paint
- 6. Shrubs/trees overgrown
- 7. Deck deteriorated and/or in need of staining
- 8. Recreational equipment stored at front property
- 9. Mailbox rusted
- 10. Grass and/or flowerbed overgrown

Inspections are currently being done in the townhomes off of Little Rocky Run Circle and the single-family homes off of Stonefield Drive.



Selling Your House?

As of July 1997, Virginia House Bill 2565 provides that the delivery of **property owners' association disclosure documents** cannot be varied by agreement or waived.

All new home buyers **MUST** receive LRR HOA disclosure documents from the seller. These documents "disclose" all information relating to the ownership of the home, including outstanding delinquencies and architectural violations.

Please contact the office of Summit Management Services, Inc. (agent for Little Rocky Run HOA), at least two (2) weeks prior to your sale to ensure receipt of the documents. You do not need to wait for a purchaser to order the resale packet. Fireworks Safety

The Fourth of July just would not be the same without those breathtaking fireworks. However, those beautiful fireworks can turn your holiday into a tragedy within seconds. Many people are injured each year in Fairfax County due to fireworks. Some are injured seriously and left with permanent damage.

Any firework, which explodes, emits a flame or sparks higher than 12 feet, or performs as a projectile is prohibited by the Fairfax County Fire Prevention Code. A permit is required for the sale of all fireworks, and these permits are only valid from June 1 to July 15 of each year.

Many fireworks are not available in Northern Virginia because they are illegal. Firecrackers, cherry bombs and skyrockets are just a few examples of fireworks which may be purchased in other areas, but are illegal here. Since even the possession of unapproved fireworks is prohibited in Fairfax County, such fireworks will be confiscated and the person possessing them can be charged with a Class 1 misdemeanor. This carries a maximum penalty of a \$2,500 fine and/or one-year in jail.

Please adhere to the following safety tips:

- When displaying legally purchased, approved fireworks, place them on a flat surface, clear of any combustible material and clear of all buildings.
- Keep all bystanders at least 25 feet away from fireworks.
- Read the directions.
- Do not permit young children to handle or light fireworks.
- Light only one firework at a time.
- Never throw fireworks.
- Sparklers can be very dangerous and account for the majority of injuries. Pieces can break off and burn bystanders.
- Young children should not use sparklers as these can attain a temperature as high as 1800 degrees Fahrenheit.
- Store fireworks in a cool, dry place.

Please have a safe Fourth of July and stay away from dangerous and illegal fireworks. Remember that there are many public displays available that offer a safe way to view fireworks.
