Leaves and Lawn Debris

Please remember that all raked and collected lawn debris and leaves must be put out in clear plastic bags on the appropriate pickup days. Lawn debris bags should be put out no sooner than the evening before the scheduled pickup day, and should be placed at the curb IN FRONT OF YOUR HOME. Contracted lawn services are not to bag and put your leaves at curbside days before these pickup days.

Leaves are not to be raked or blown into the street, the common areas or neighboring properties. Little Rocky Run does not have a public loose leave pickup, which allows residents to pile their leaves in the street for mass pickup.

Piles of Newspapers

It has come to our attention that many residents of the single-family properties are allowing newspapers to accumulate at the base of their mailbox posts, in their driveways and at the entrance into the private pipestem drives. This is a violation of the Architectural and Maintenance Standards, distracts from the beauty of the community and is a possible safety and security concern, as it can appear that a home is vacant or that no one is at home for an extended period of time.

Many of these newspapers are free deliveries, which homeowners have not subscribed to, ordered or care to receive. A few of these papers are the Centre View and the Fairfax County Times.

Winter / Holiday Service Schedule

Dear Little Rocky Run,

Happy Holidays! As we all enter the busy Holiday season, we would like to remind you of the upcoming collection schedule and inclement weather policies.

Thanksgiving Day: Office is closed and no services will be provided. **Single Family Homes!!** Since your regular trash & recycling pickup falls on this day, trash & recycling collection make up day will be the Saturday after the holiday (**November 30th**).**

Christmas Day & New Year's Day: Falls on a Wednesday this year. Office is closed and no services will be provided. Since your collection does not fall on this day, there will be no interruption in service collection days.

On make-up days, crews come through neighborhoods earlier than normal, please make sure residents put their items curbside the night before.

Yard Debris Collection: Ends effective December 24th. If you have yard debris to be collected after this date, place your items to curbside on your 2nd collection day until yard debris season resumes the 1st week of March.

Christmas Tree Collection: Single family and multi-dwelling attached homes, Christmas trees will be collected the on January 4th and January 8th. We ask all tinsel and decorations be removed. Please do not place trees in plastic bags.

Inclement Weather: Safety in your community is our primary concern. Roads and/or areas which are deemed unsafe due to snow or ice will be suspended for collection. If suspension occurs, services will resume based on the contract terms.

Watch Out For Deer

Deer breeding season is here which means increased numbers of deer on the roadways. Deer-vehicle collisions are a serious public safety concern. The Fairfax County wildlife biologist and police urge motorist to be alert, drive with caution and remember these safety tips:

Watch for eye shine along roadsides. Deer travel in herds, if you see one, others may be near. Use high beams to spot them at a greater distance. Slow down! Deer become mesmerized by bright steady lights. Flash your headlights.

Deer are most active between 6-9 pm. Be aware and alert when traveling at these times.

Be Aware of "Deer Crossing" signs. Signs are placed in areas known for high deer traffic and/or deervehicle collisions.

If a deer jumps in your vehicle's path, grasp the steering wheel firmly with both hands and reduce your speed. You never know when a deer will attempt to cross the road.

Never swerve to avoid a deer on the road. Attempting to swerve may cause loss of control of the vehicle and increase the chance of more serious injury or damage.

If a collision is inevitable, grip the steering wheel tightly and take your foot off the brake at time of impact. This will reduced the likelihood of a deer crashing through your windshield or windows upon impact.

If a deer is injured or killed, contact Fairfax County Police Department (non-emergency) at 703-691-2131.

MILDEW ON YOUR SIDING?

Distinguished for its performance, sustainability and value, vinyl siding is the leading cladding material (covering one material with another) for home exteriors. Vinyl siding panels are constructed to withstand strong winds, moisture and heat for lasting durability.
