Fee increases keep the Homeowners Association in good financial health and often are unavoidable. Typical reactions to Assessment Increases:

- **"I can't afford the increase."** Association living means willing to share the costs as prescribed in the Governing Documents that you agreed to in escrow. Not maintaining association property means real-estate values decline.
- **"I probably won't be living here in 15 years when the streets need repaving. Why should I have to pay now?"** The problem is that current Owners are benefiting from the use of the streets, pools, tot lots, walking trails, recreation centers and other common assets paid for by members who lived there before. Members should pay for the incremental use of these items each year they live there.
- **"Why don't we just have a special assessment for a specific project?"** It is often difficult to collect money when you suddenly have a large expense. Collecting gradually assures the funds are there when needed. Special assessments also unfairly penalize Homeowners that currently live in the Community.
